Firm will not represent or assist Seller in a transaction that is a "Distressed Home 45 Conveyance" as defined by Chapter 61.34 RCW unless otherwise agreed in writing. A "Distressed Home 46 Conveyance" is a transaction where a buyer purchases property from a "Distressed Homeowner" (defined by 47 Chapter 61.34 RCW), allows the Distressed Homeowner to continue to occupy the property, and promises to 48 convey the property back to the Distressed Homeowner or promises the Distressed Homeowner an interest in, or 49 portion of, the proceeds from a resale of the property.

- 8. SELLER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT. Unless Seller is exempt under RCW 64.06, Seller shall provide to Buyer 51 as soon as reasonably practicable a completed and signed "Seller Disclosure Statement" (Form 17 (Residential), 52 Form 17C (Unimproved Residential), or Form 17 (Commercial). Seller agrees to indemnify, defend and hold Firm 53 harmless from and against any and all claims that the information Seller provides on Form 17, Form 17C, or Form 17 Commercial is inaccurate.
- DAMAGES IN THE EVENT OF BUYER'S BREACH. In the event Seller retains earnest money as liquidated 56 damages on Buyer's breach, any costs advanced or committed by Firm on Seller's behalf shall be paid therefrom 57 and the balance divided equally between Seller and Firm.
- 10. ATTORNEYS' FEES. In the event either party employs an attorney to enforce any terms of this Agreement and 59 is successful, the other party agrees to pay reasonable attorneys' fees. In the event of trial, the successful party shall be entitled to an award of attorneys' fees and expenses; the amount of the attorneys' fees and expenses 61 shall be fixed by the court. The venue of any suit shall be the county in which the Property is located. 62
